**RED:** love and brave

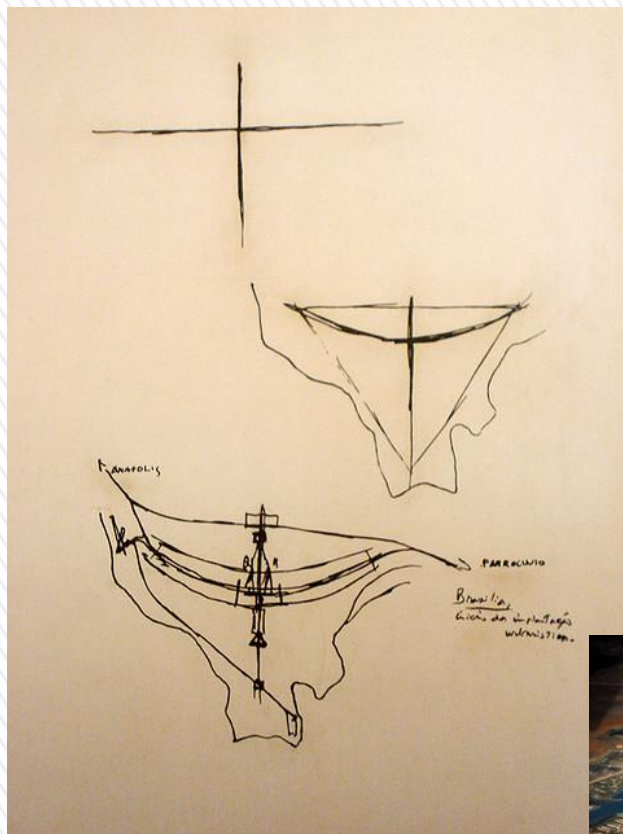


# CAPITAL

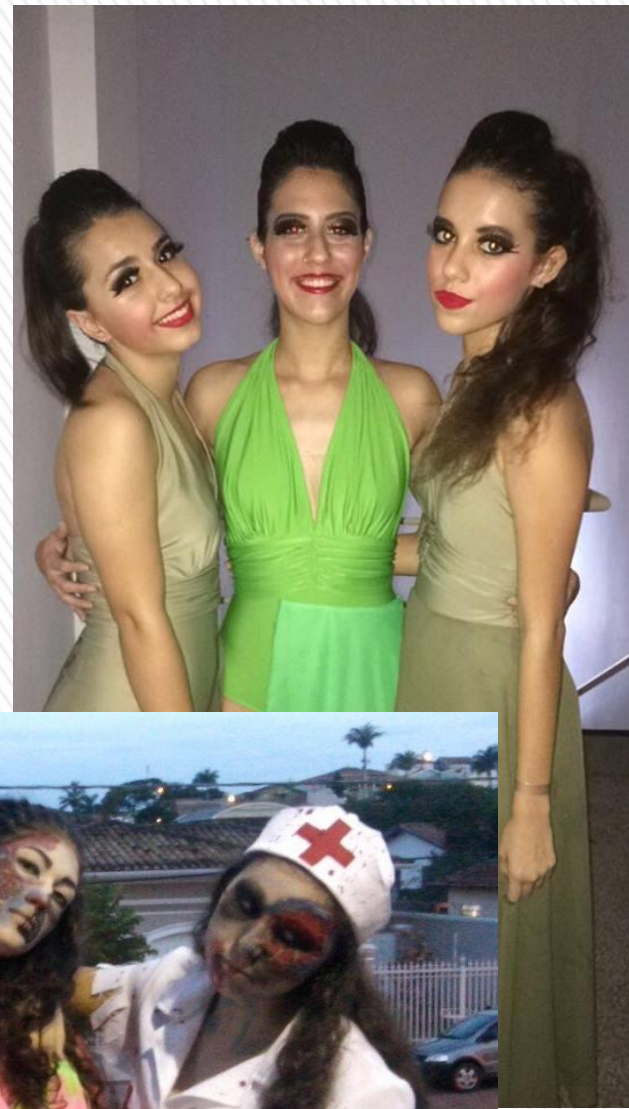
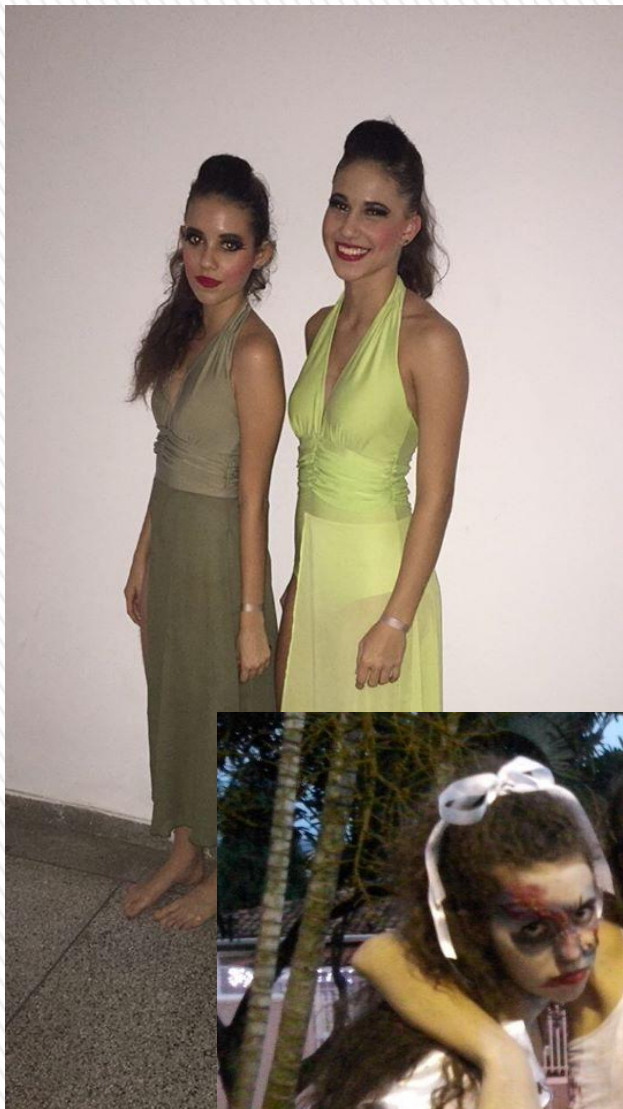

# FOOD - COMIDAS

## COXINHA



Little raindrops fried, usually filled with chicken

## BRIGADEIRO



Chocolate truffles made with condensed milk and covered in chocolate sprinkles.

## PÃO DE QUEIJO



Little rolls of bread with cheese baked into it.

## PASTEL



Fried, you can fill with cheese, beef, fish, chicken and whatever you want.



## FEIJOADA



A black bean stew with various types of beef and sausage.

## ACARAJÉ



A black-eyed pea ball fried in palm oil, usually stuffed with shrimp and vinaigrette – From Bahia

## FAROFA



Fried cassava flour. It can include egg, bacon, and other add-ons. It's usually sprinkled over rice and beans.

## AÇAÍ



A berry used to make fruit bowls and smoothies. Blend with bananas and strawberries and top with granola and honey.

# HOLIDAYS:CARNAVAL

- » **History:** when Brazil belonged to Portugal, the carnival was a party celebrated by slaves and repressed by high society, but became popular only in the 20th century.
- » The party happens for four days, 47 days before Easter, often in February (It may be near of the Chinese New Year).
- » The Rio de Janeiro street carnival is designated by Guinness World Records as the largest carnival in the world, with approximately two million people per day.





# SAMBA:

- » Appear in the 1920s.
- » Samba schools work the whole year to be judged in a single presentation in the competition during the Carnaval.
